



McKesson Canada Taking Care of Our Own Fund

Caring about each other is part of what makes McKesson special. That's especially true in tough times.

One of the ways we help one another is through the McKesson Canada Taking Care of Our Own Fund. You can apply for a grant when you face a natural disaster, catastrophe or family emergency.

This Guide will help you quickly figure out if you are eligible and how to apply for a grant.

Who Can Apply?

You can apply if you're a McKesson Canada employee who works 20+ hours weekly. You can also apply if you are on approved leave (including short-term disability, medical leave or paid/unpaid time off).



The Fund is administered by the Emergency Assistance Foundation (EAF), our trusted partner. When you contact the Fund, you will hear directly from EAF.

How to Apply?

You can apply for **two types of grants**, depending on your situation.



1. When You Need to Evacuate

When you're in the path of a large-scale disaster, like a major storm, you may need to evacuate. If that happens to you, you can apply for a **\$1,000 Get You to Safety Grant** to help with your expenses. You will need to provide your personal contact information and location. (Tip: Use an email address that you can access from where you are.)

Apply at www.mckessoncares.ca. After you apply:

- Look for an auto-responder from EAF (Emergency Assistance Foundation).
- Once approved, app@echecks.com will send you an email containing your electronic check.



2. When You Face Personal Hardship

If you're facing financial hardship from an unexpected event, you can apply for a **We Care Grant of up to \$5,000**. The event could be an accident, house fire, or other emergency. Or it could be medical expenses that your health insurance doesn't cover. To make sure we help those who need help most, income guidelines apply for this type of grant. See the FAQs for a list of qualifying events and expenses.

- Go to www.mckessoncares.ca and select "Apply for a Grant." Register and you'll receive an email with the application link.
- Submit your application. (It will go faster if you have your expense receipts ready to upload.)
- The Emergency Assistance Foundation will review your application. They will email you if they need more information. Expect to hear back by email within three business days.
- If you are approved, look for an email from app@echecks.com. You will receive an email containing your electronic check.
